


What we do with our devices at Gretton School







Arriving at school

When I arrive at school in the morning, I will place my devices/phone in a bag like the one in the picture to the left.

This is the same for all learners in the school.



The bag will have my name on it.

It will be placed in a box with my class name on.

It will be kept safe during the day in school, until the end of the day (home time)









At the end of the day, there will be staff to hand me my phone/device as I leave the school or get in my taxi so I can take it home.

If I need to leave early, that's OK. My device/phone will still be given back to me as I leave.









Phones I can use in school

If I have a **Nokia 3220 or 3310 or another type of 'dumbphone'**, I will be able to keep this with me.

I must follow the Devices Charter, when using the phone to talk to my parents/carers.

These devices must not be 'data enabled'.

If I do not have a phone like this, staff will help me and give me the chance to speak with my parents/carers if I need to.





Chromebooks I can use in school

I will still have my **Chromebook** during lessons to help me complete my work.

I can also use my Chromebook during break/lunch times.

Chromebooks have 'internet filters' on them. I may understand why I cannot access a site, but filters are there to keep everybody safe.

There will be some games that you can access and you will be able to listen to music too.









Listening to music

I can use my chromebook to listen to music with headphones.

Chromebooks will have **bluetooth** enabled so I can listen to the music using my own headphones.









I can bring a small MP3 player, Switch or Kindle as long as these devices are not data enabled.

Learners must follow the Devices Charter for these devices.





Independent travel

Where an adult is not with me during planned independent travel I will be given my phone (not other internet enabled devices) for safety reasons.

Phones are not needed during transition between sites because this is frequently staffed and learners are supported to travel safely.

Learners not feeling or being safe, may be escorted by a member of staff between sites.
